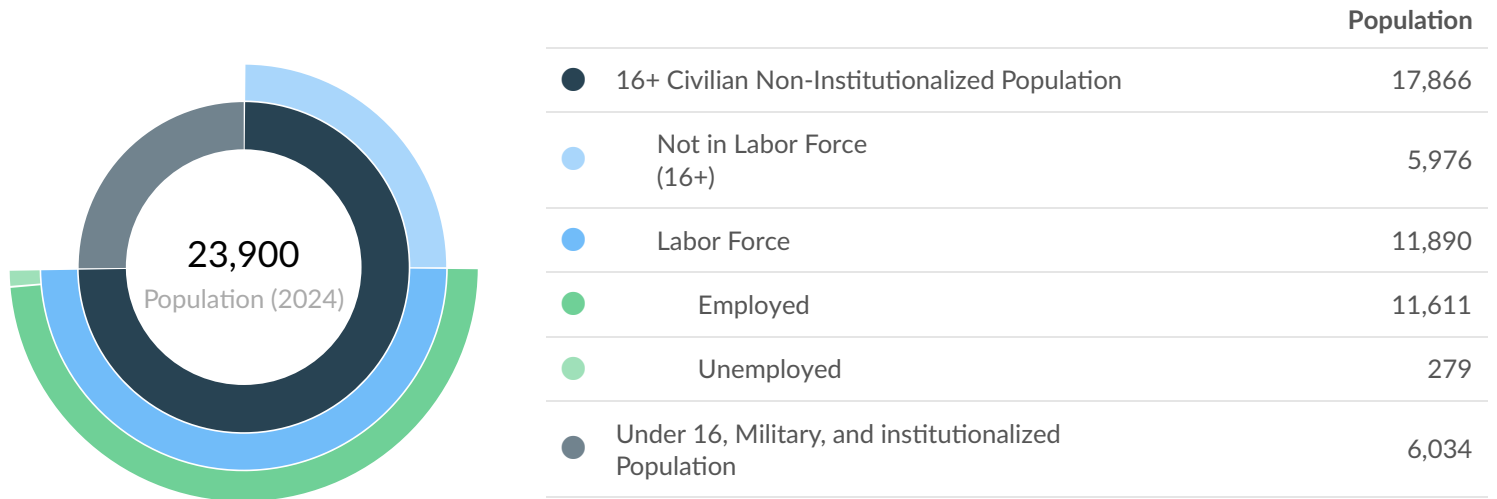
Median household income is **\$2.0K below** the national median household income of \$69.0K.

- As of 2023 the region's population **increased by 3.7%** since 2018, growing by 848. Population is expected to **increase by 4.9%** between 2023 and 2028, adding 1,148.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs **increased by 0.6%** in Yankton County, SD from 14,295 to **14,385**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 3.3%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 67.6% to 66.6% between 2018 and 2023**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **17.5% of Yankton County, SD residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.6% below the national average), and **12.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.7% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, General Medical and Surgical Hospitals, and Agriculture, Construction, and Mining Machinery Manufacturing.

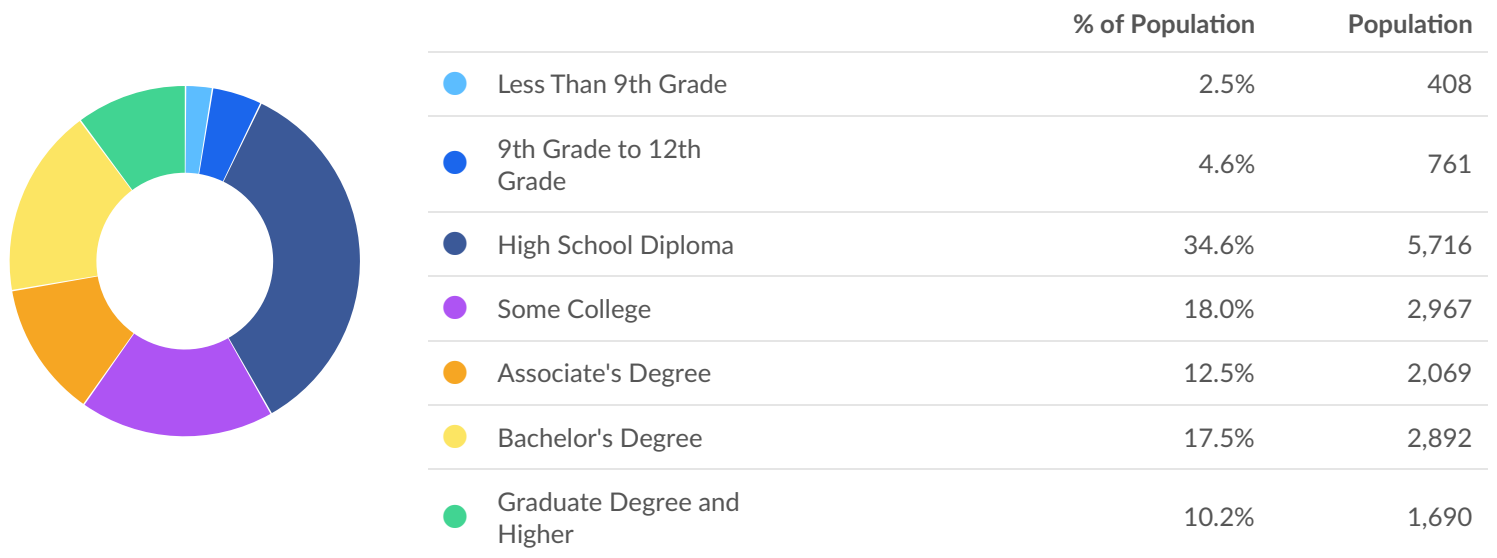

Feb 2024 Labor Force Breakdown



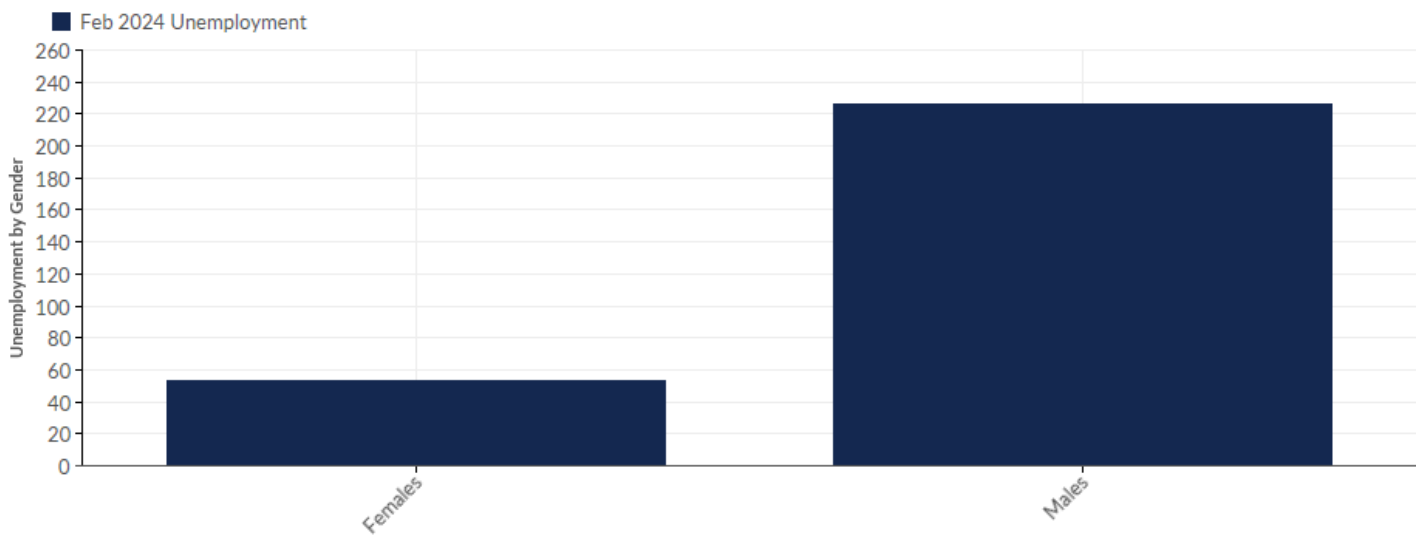
Educational Attainment

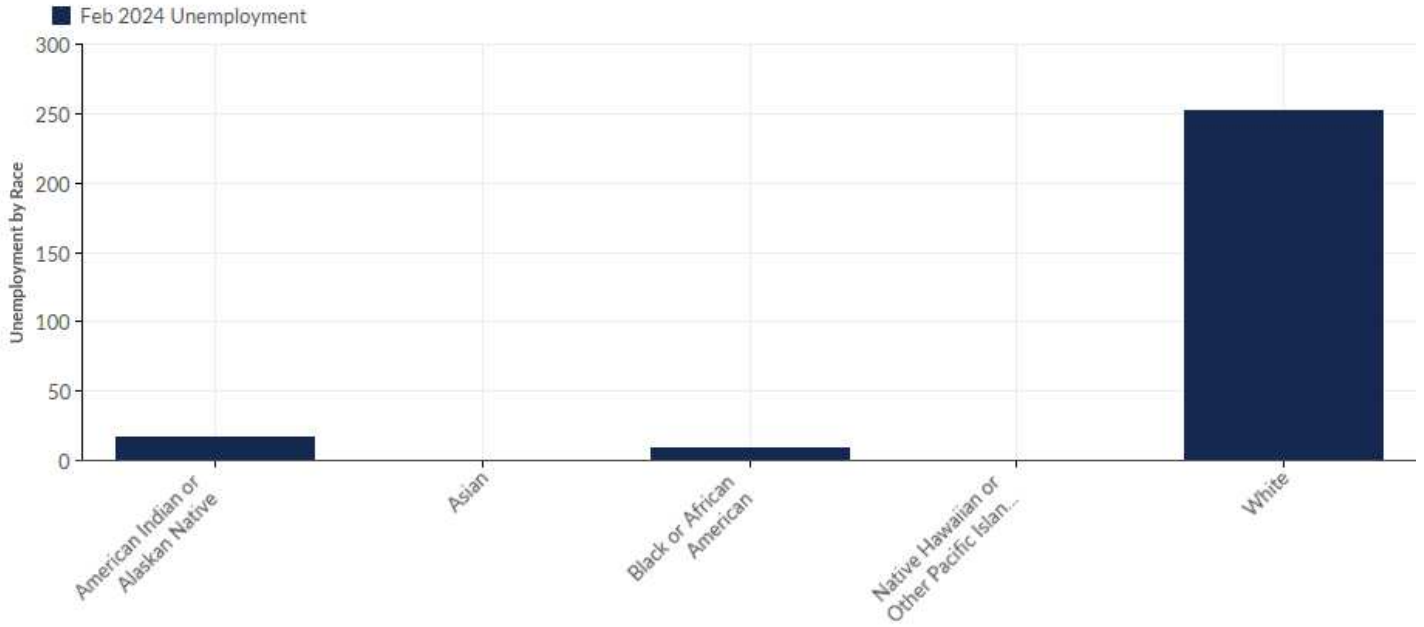
Unemployment by Demographics

Unemployment by Gender



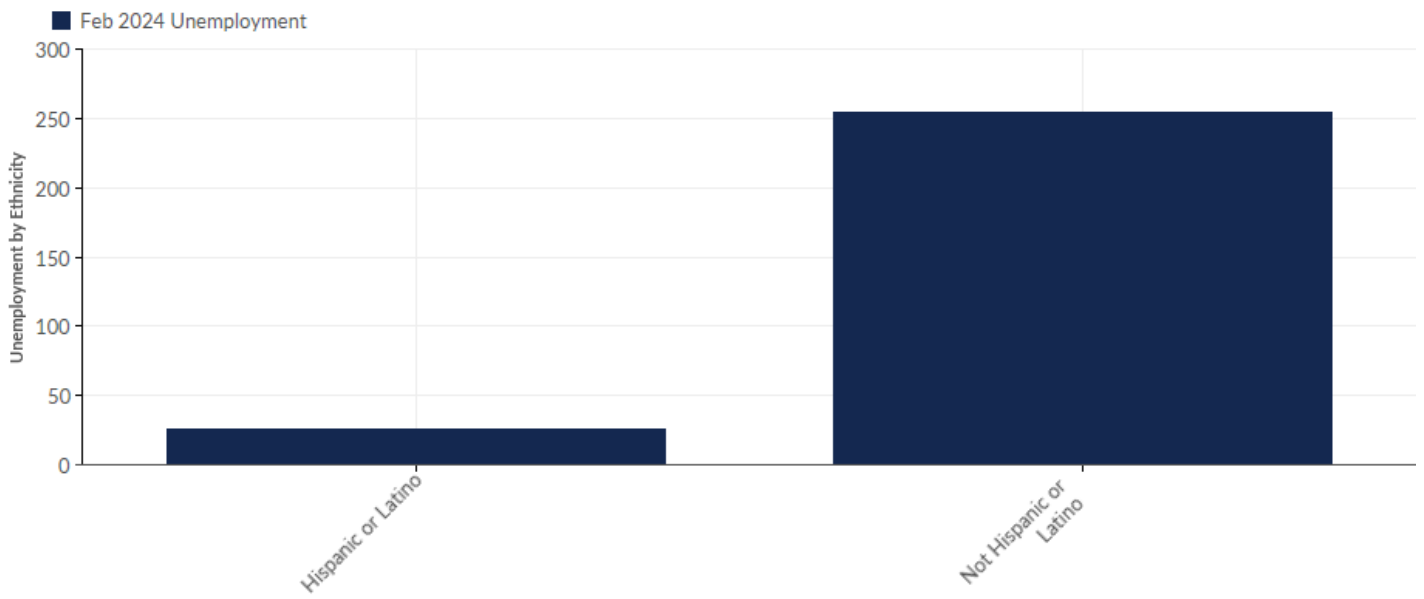

Unemployment by Ethnicity

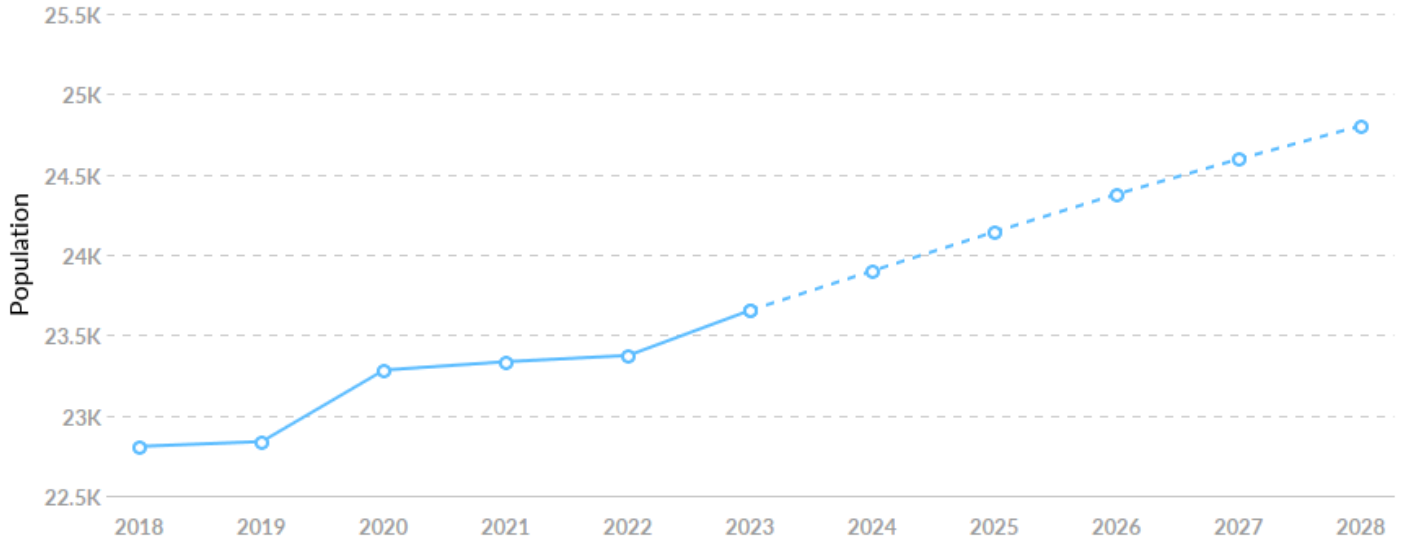

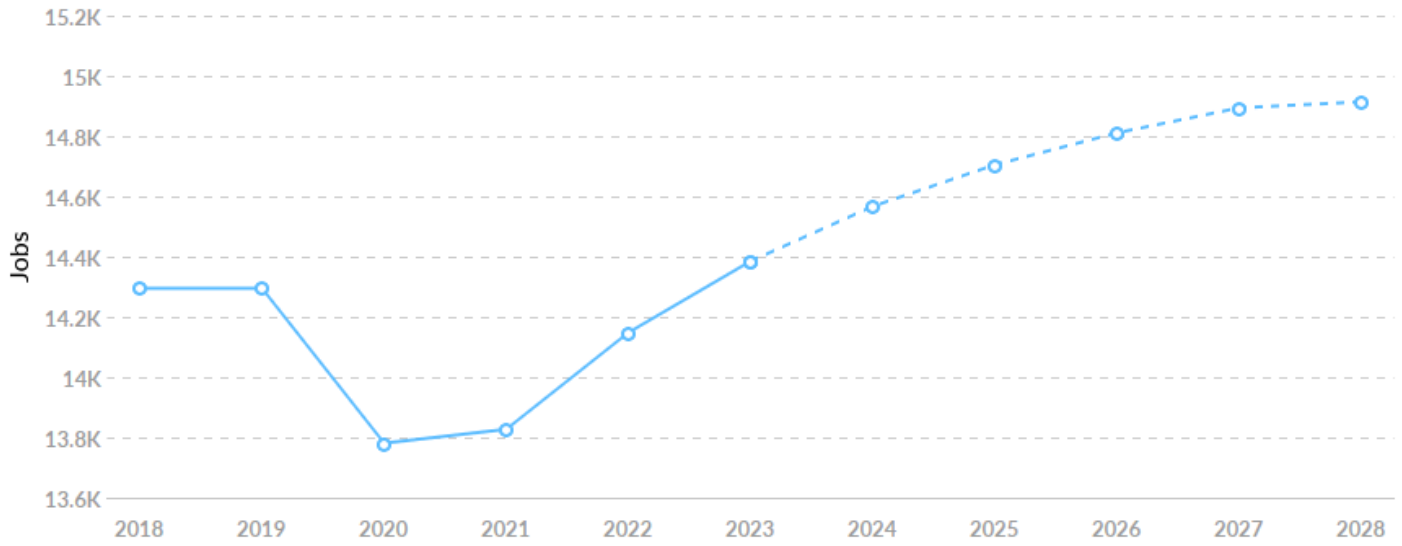

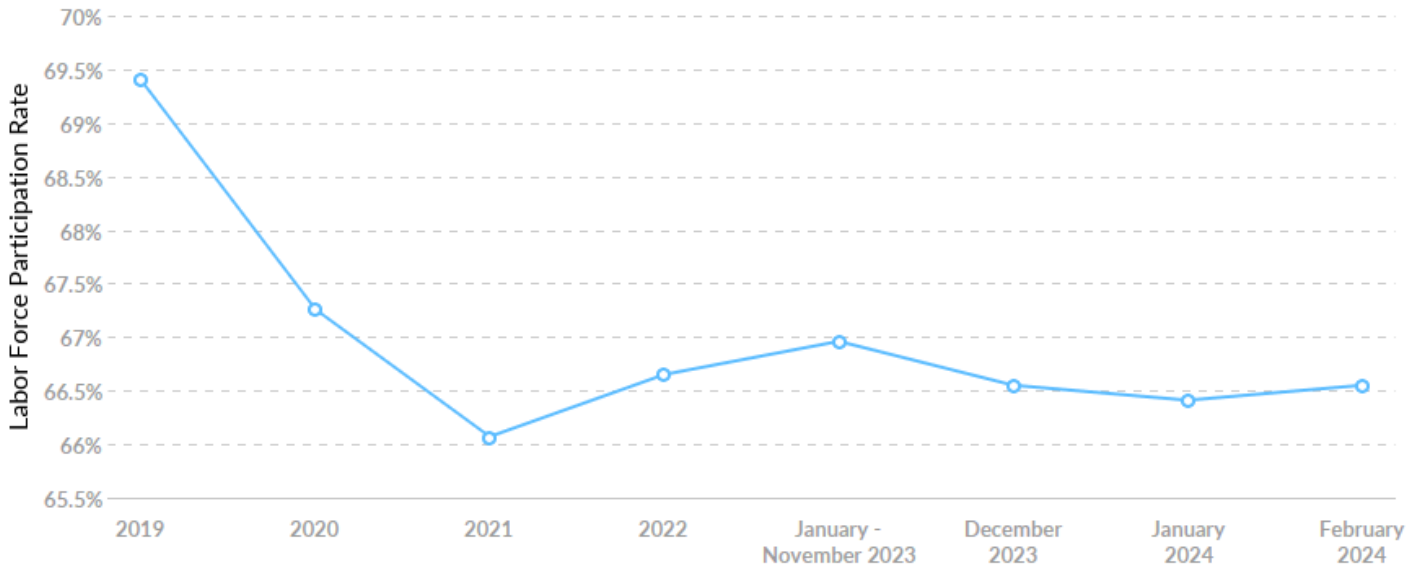
Job Trends

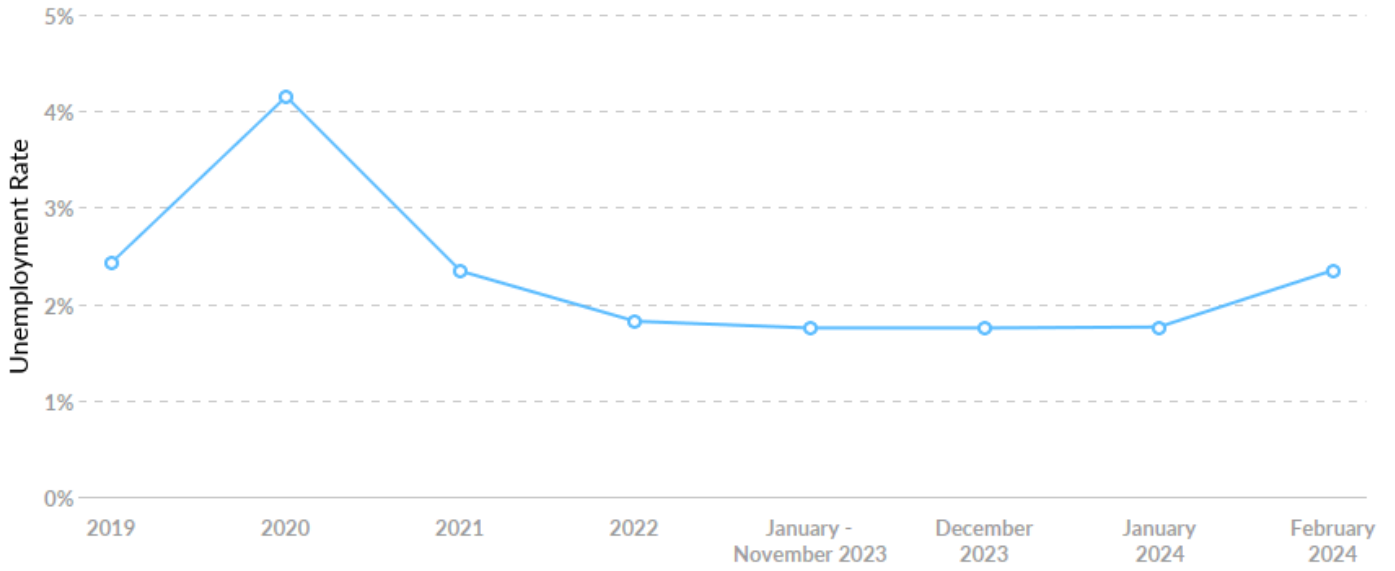

Yankton County, SD had a February 2024 unemployment rate of 2.35%, **decreasing from 2.43%** 5 years before.

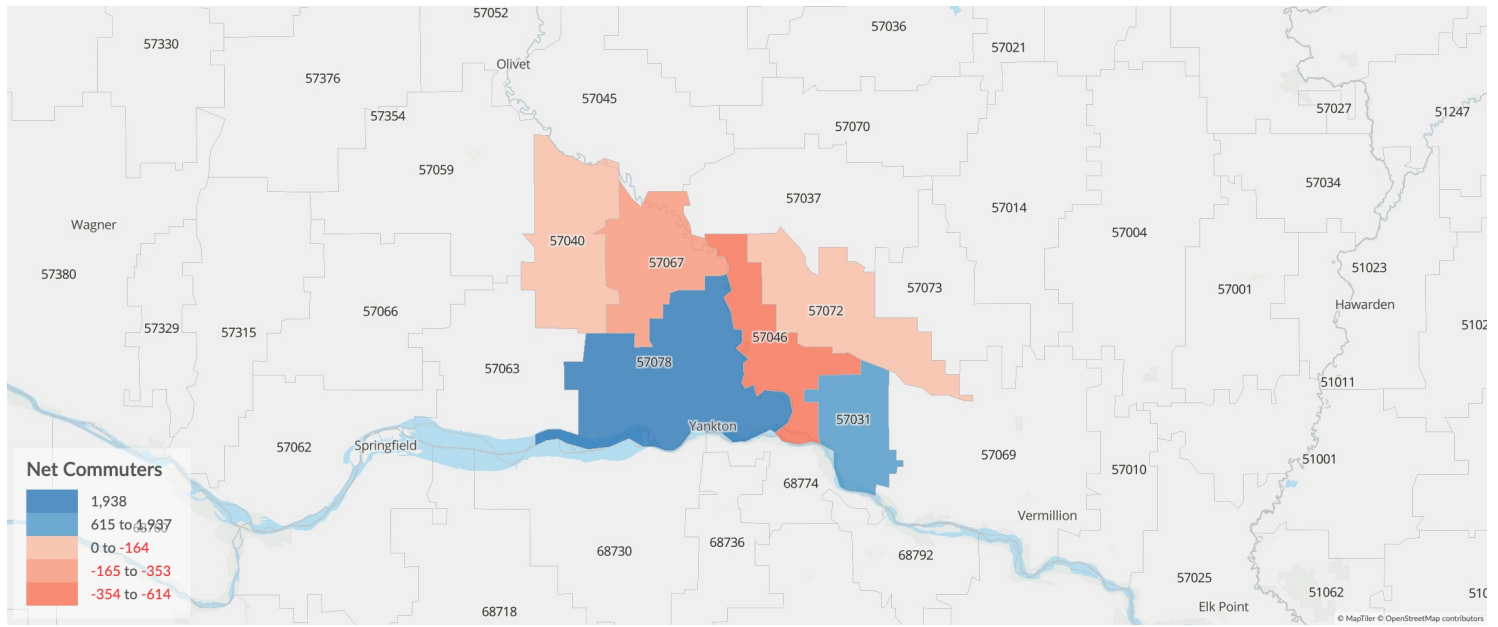

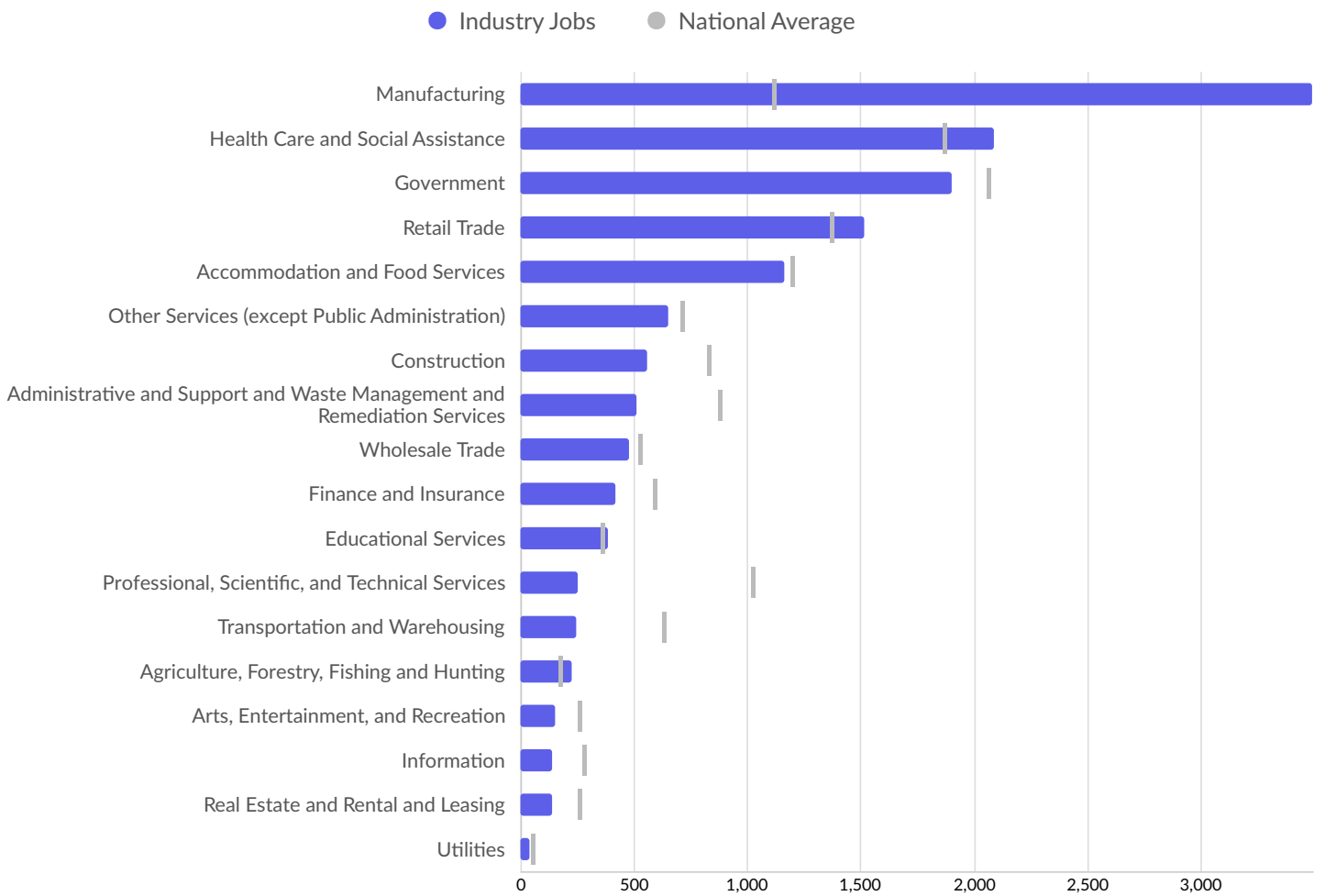

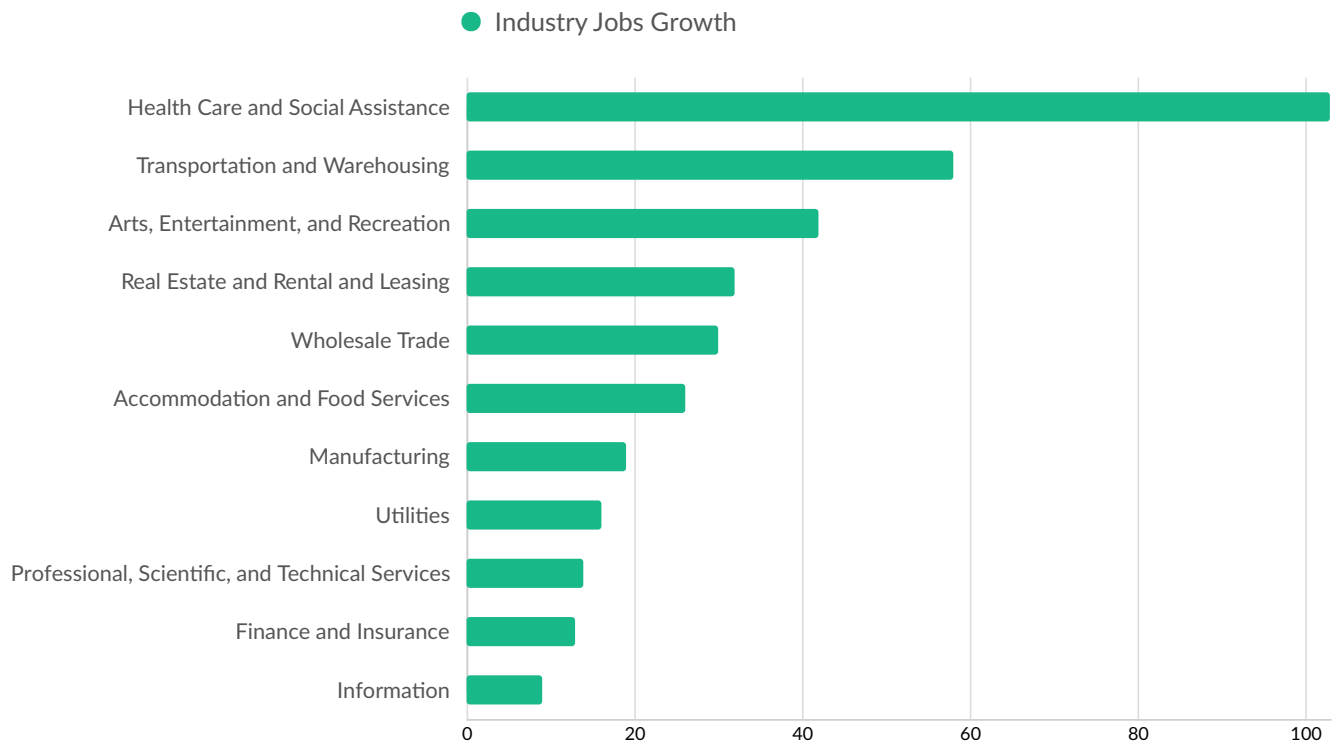

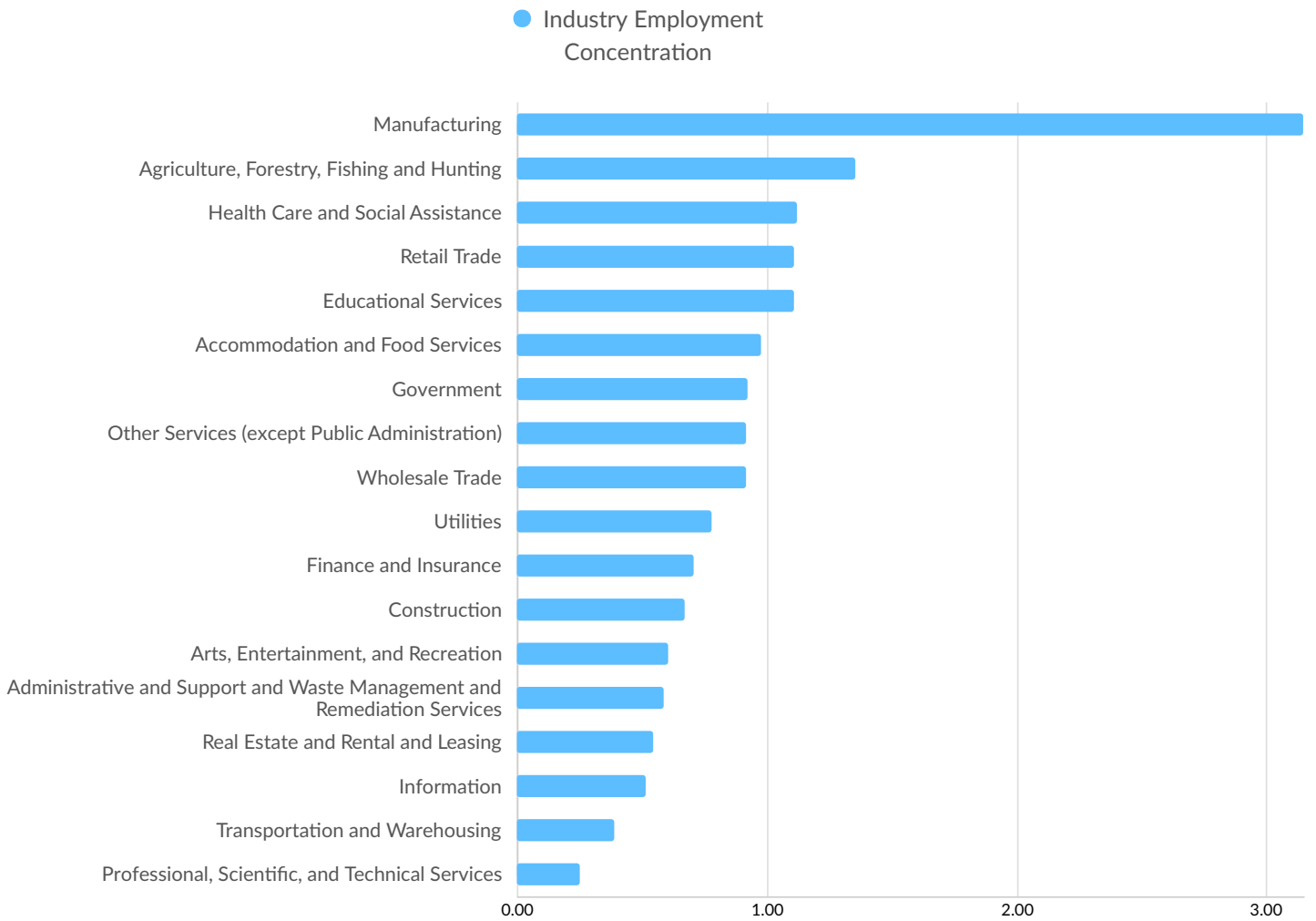

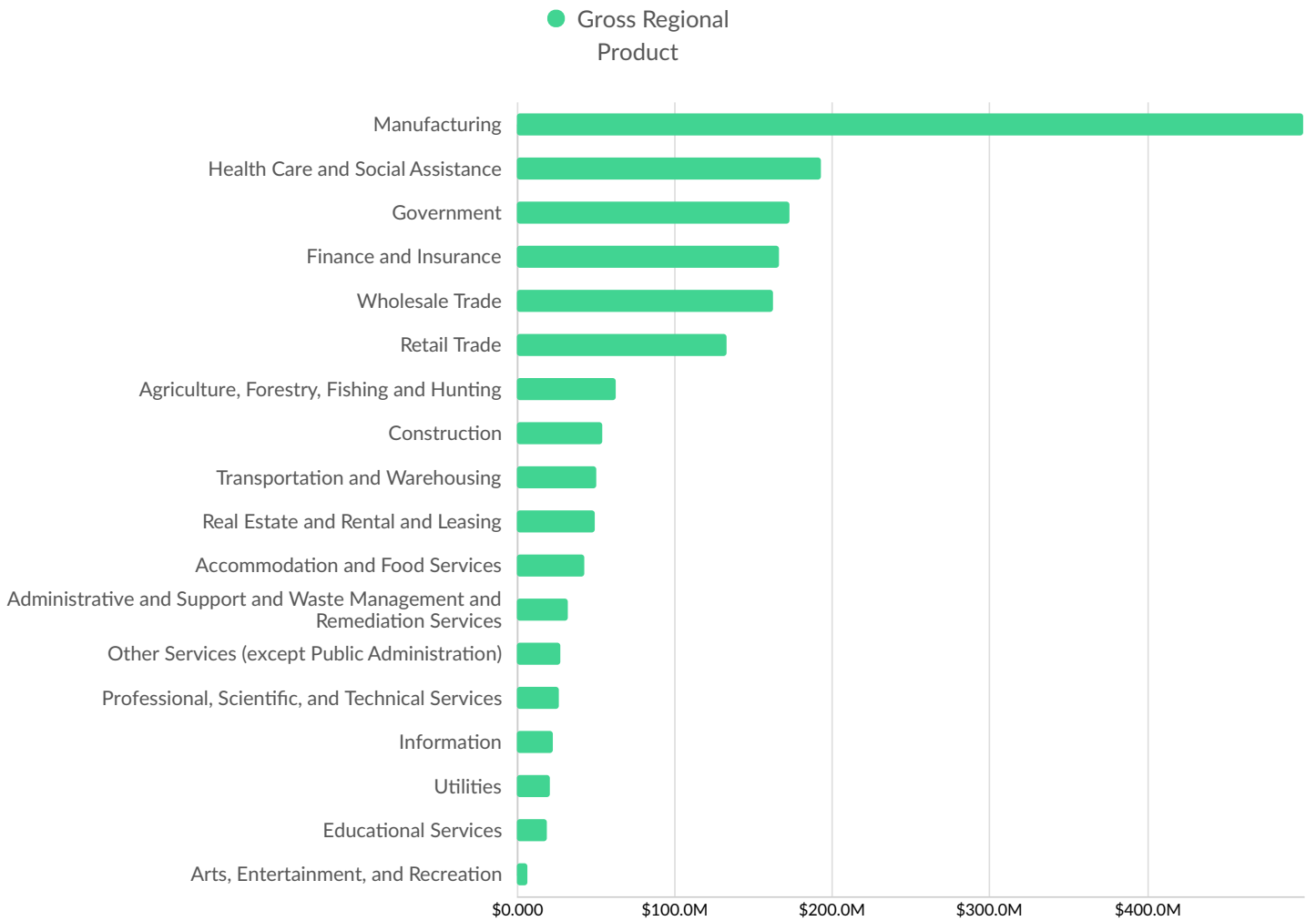
Top Growing Industries



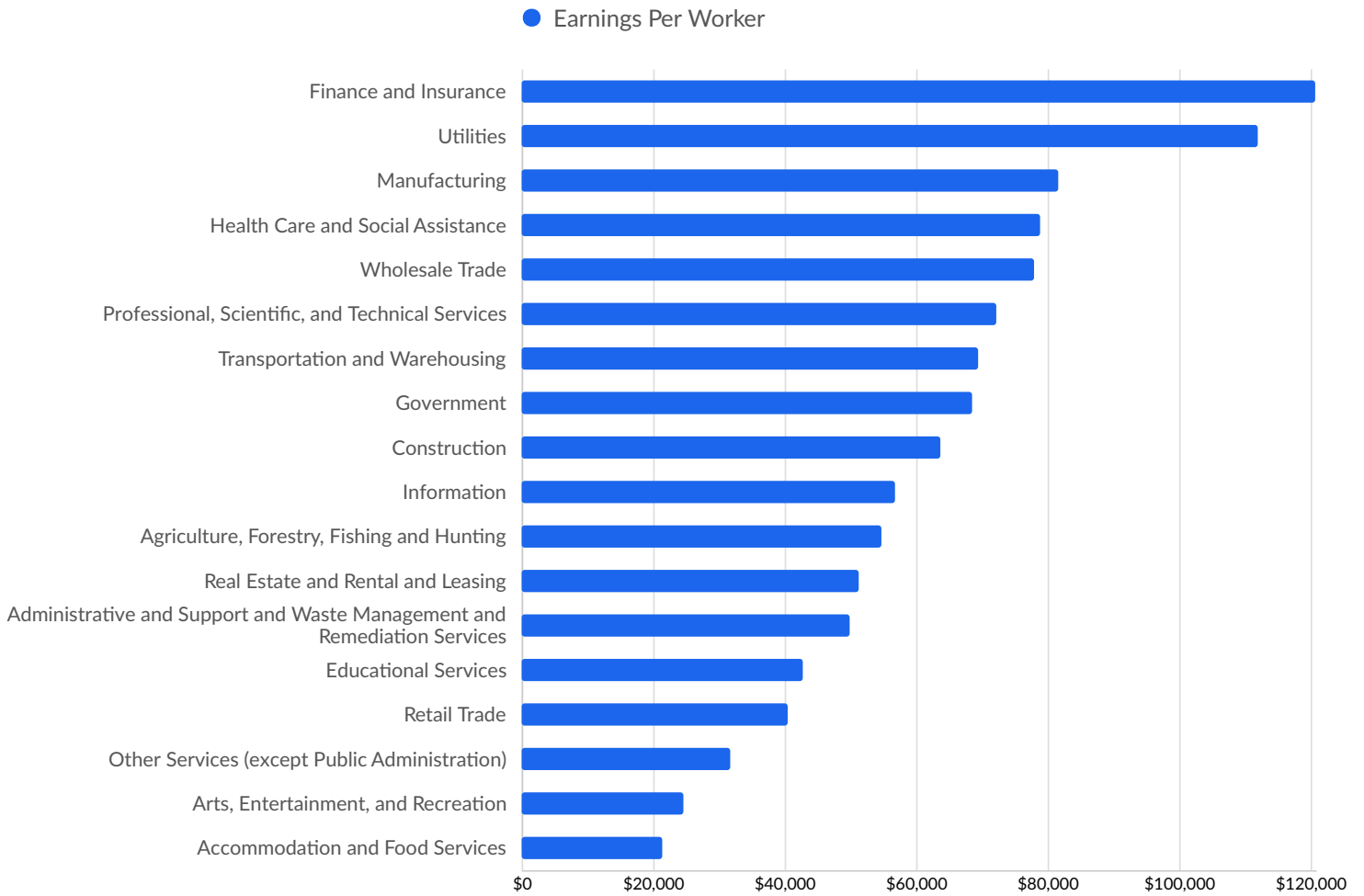
Top Industry Employment Concentration

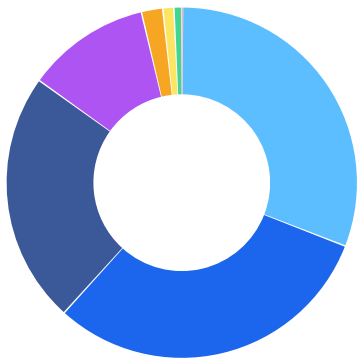

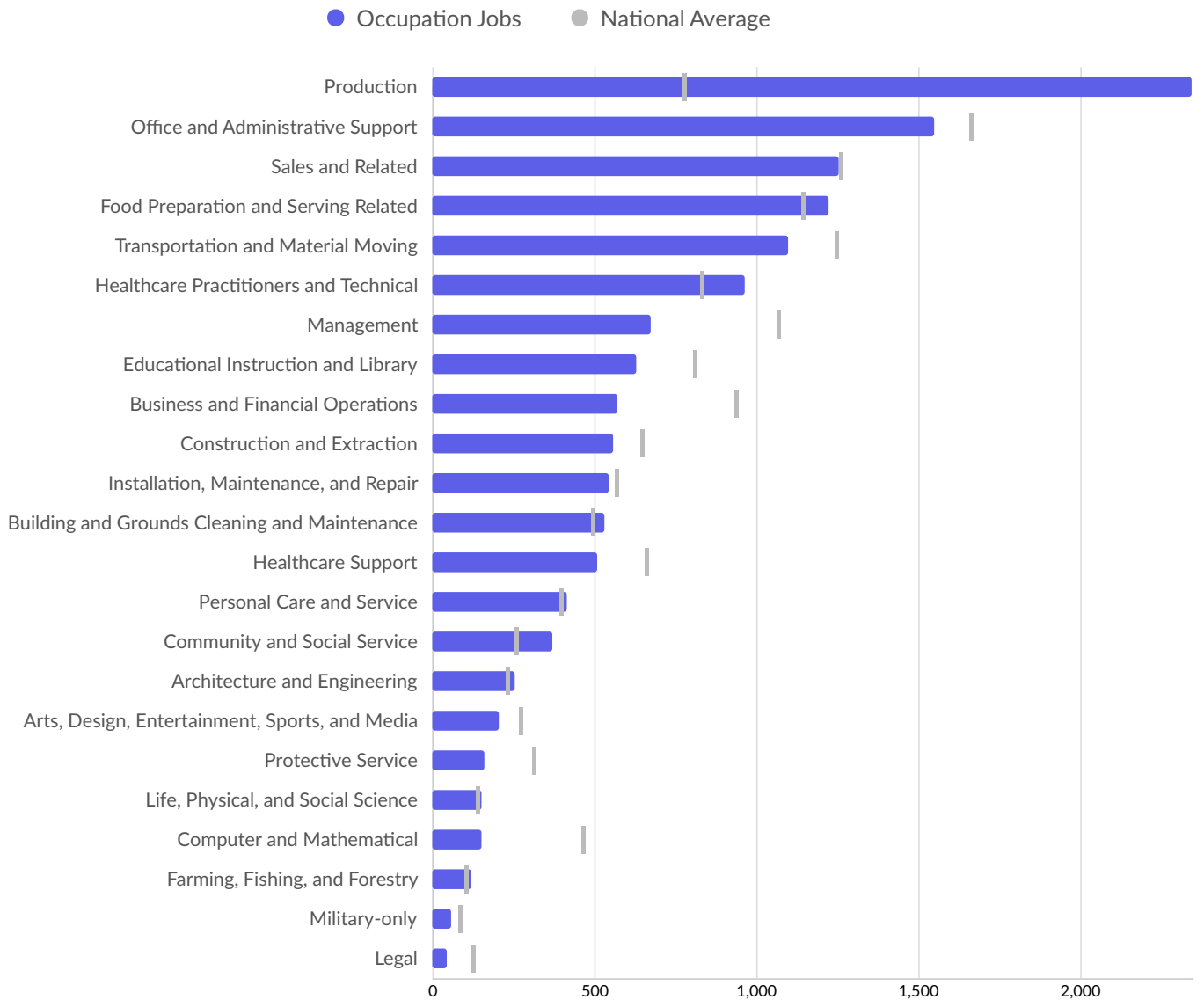

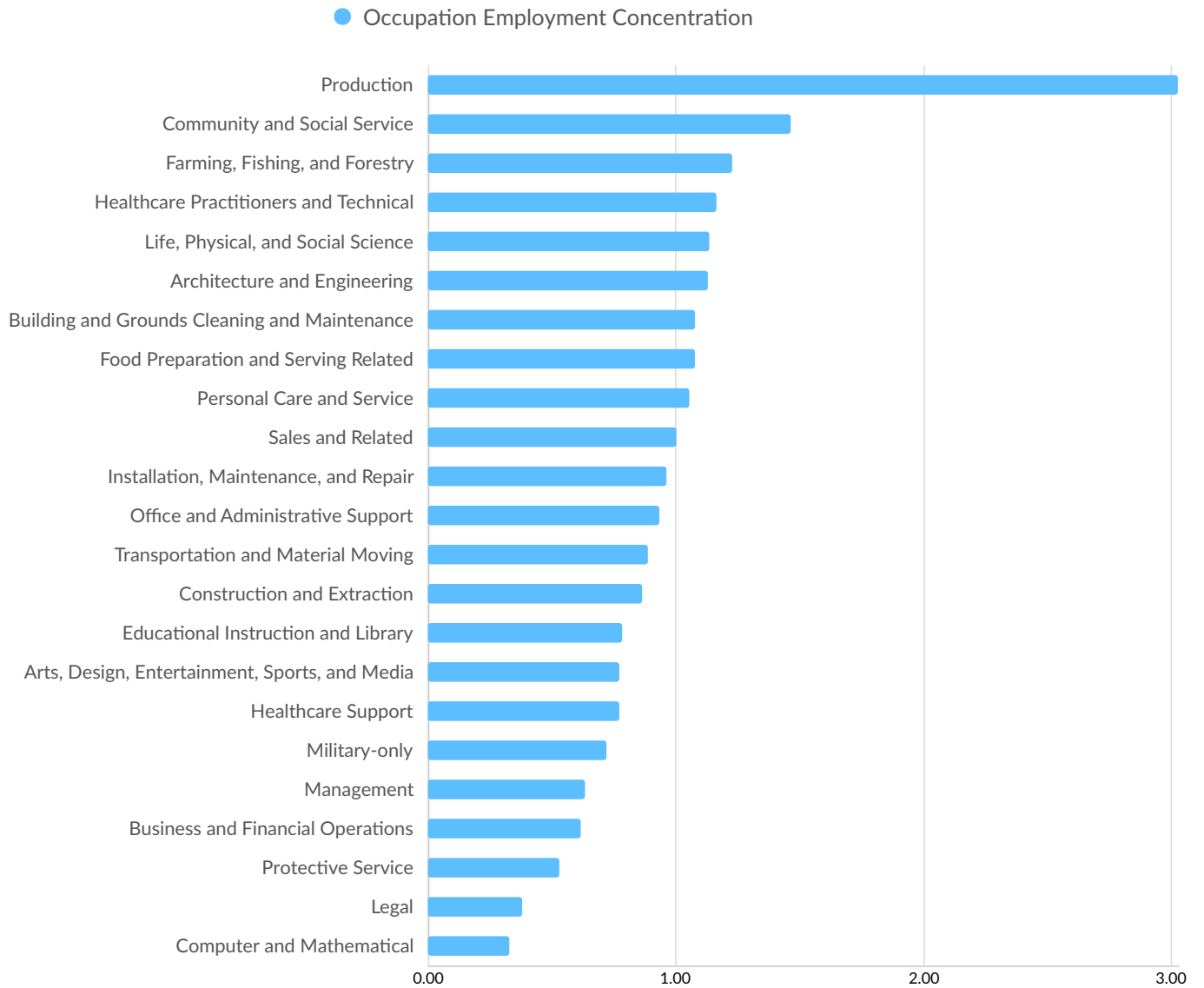

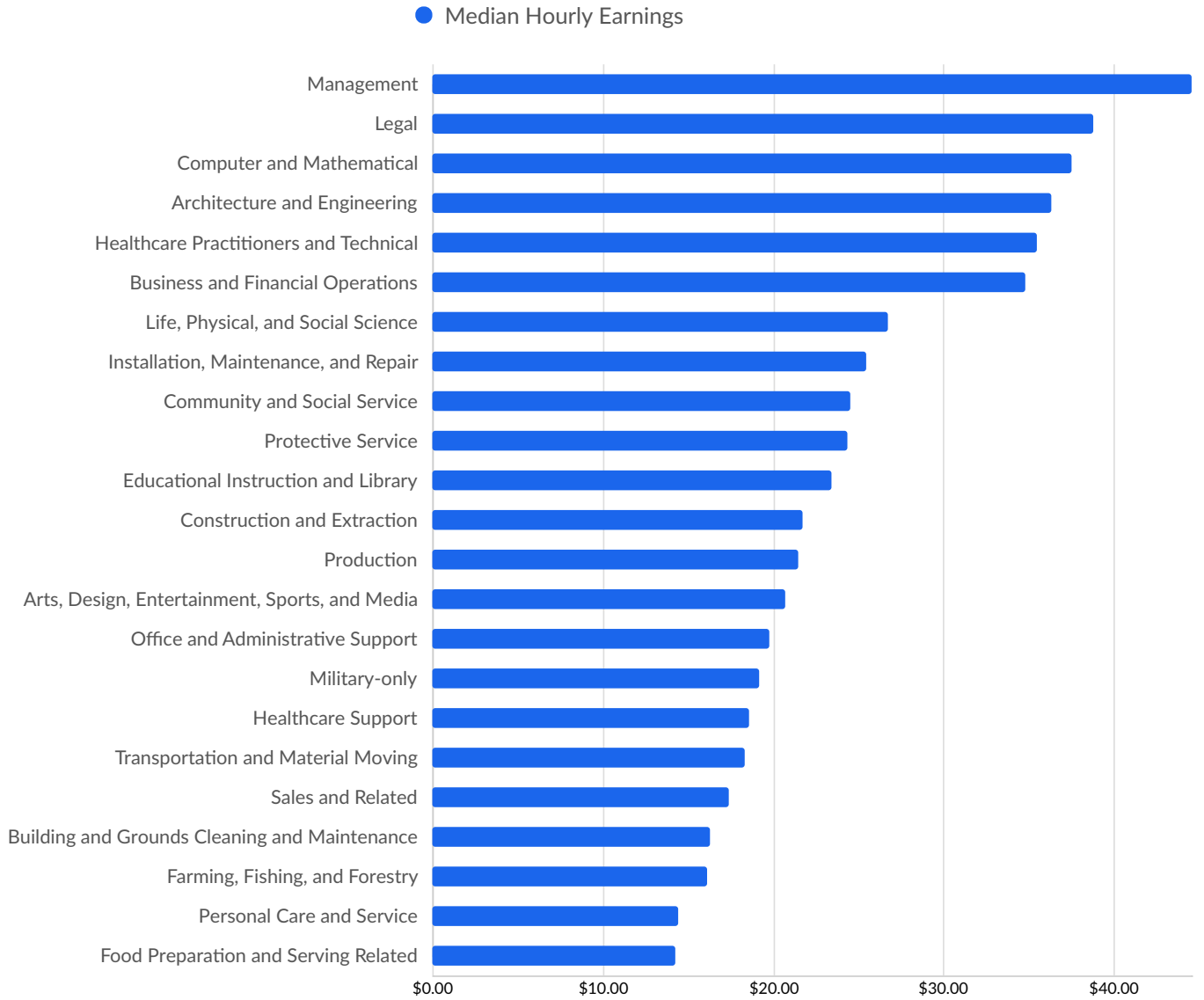
Top Growing Occupations



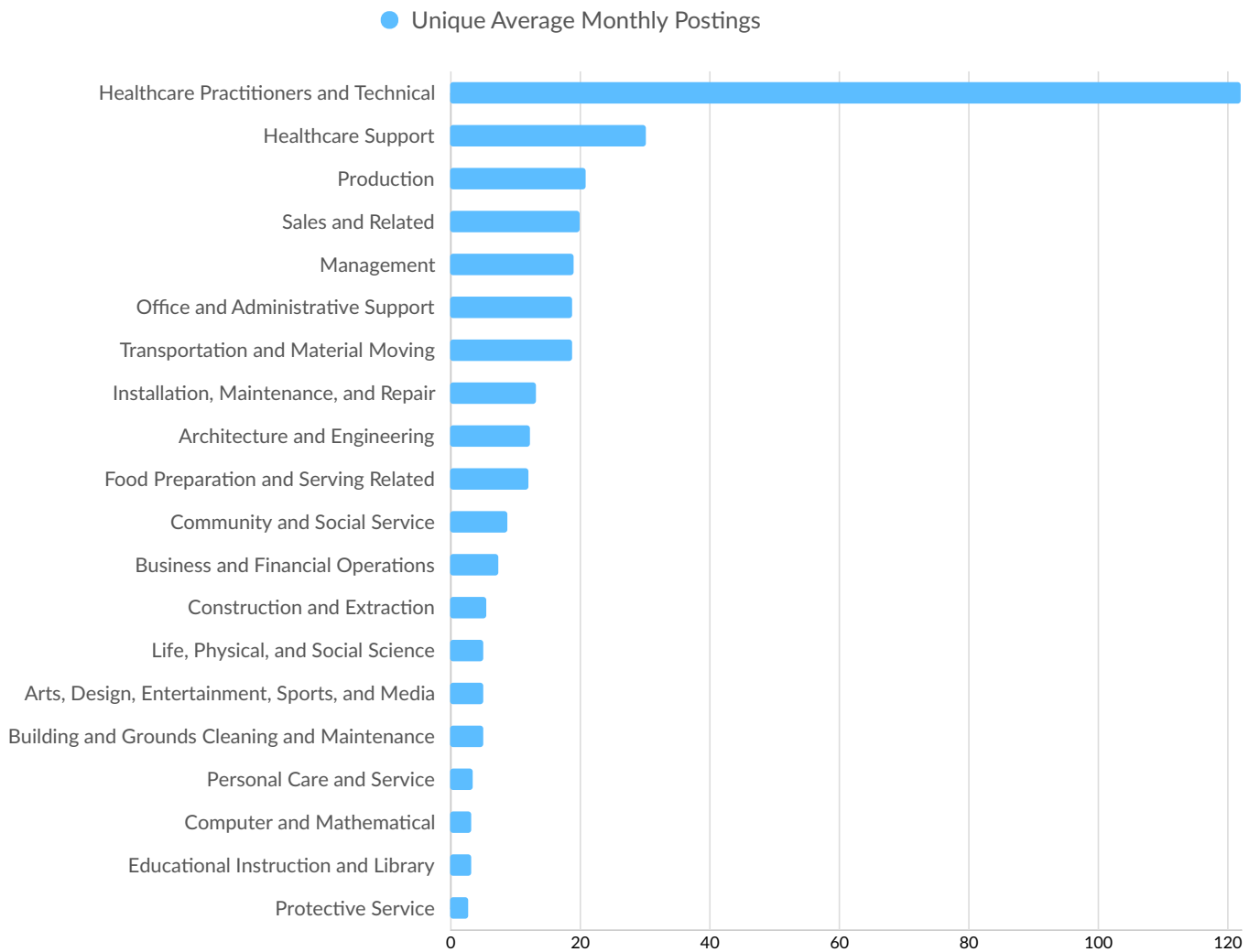
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



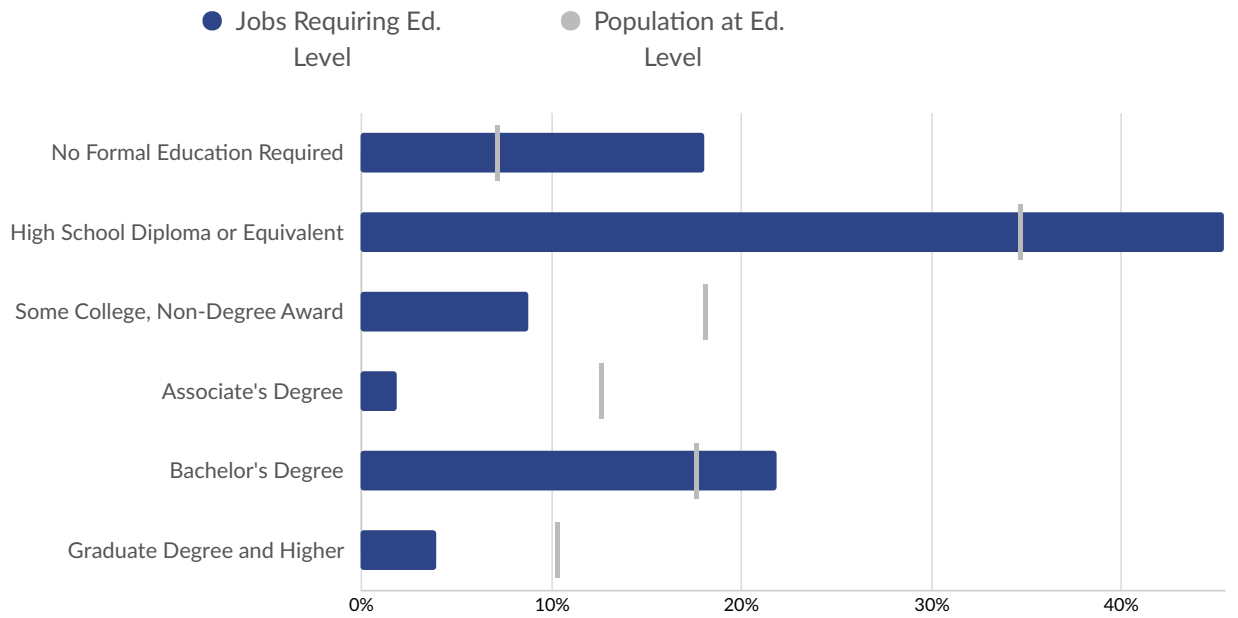
Top Occupation Earnings

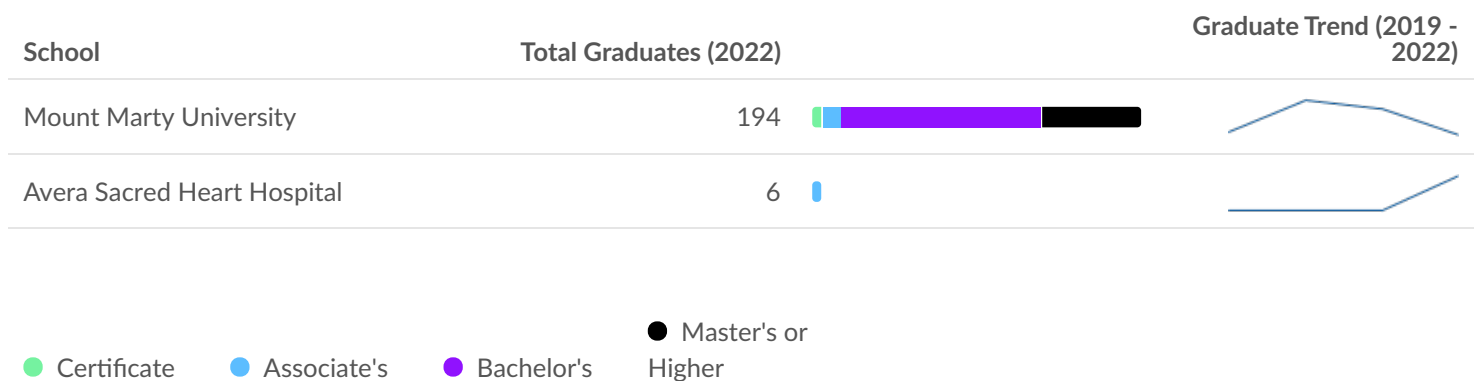
